"MARIANUM" FEMALE RESIDENCE

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The Collegio Universitario Don Nicola Mazza provides accommodation places for female students at the Marianum Residence in Padua.

1. WHO CAN PARTICIPATE

The competition is open to Italian and international female students who intend to enrol or are already enrolled in three-year bachelor's, master's, or single-cycle degree courses, as well as graduates enrolled in doctoral or specialization courses.

2. SERVICES OFFERED

The Marianum university residence is located just a few steps away from the main university faculties in Padua and is situated in an area rich in amenities. In the heart of the city, it provides convenient access to the main squares (Piazze), the train station, cultural attractions, public gardens, and youth gathering centers where students can enjoy leisure time and build relationships. The Residence offers a welcoming environment and numerous services. It is a large-scale facility that welcomes female students into comfortable and well-maintained environments, featuring equipped study rooms and stimulating contexts to foster friendship, research, and deeper learning.

3. . WHEN AND HOW TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION

Applications for accommodation can be submitted starting from May 15, 2026. To compete for the assignment of an accommodation place, candidates must submit their application online at <https://www.collegiomazza.it/candidatura-residenza-marianum-padova>. Accommodation places are assigned until all available spots are filled, following the order of the admission ranking list.

4. HOW ADMISSION WORKS

The application process requires:

- a. The registration of personal data, self-presentation elements, and information regarding your school or academic background.
- b. The uploading of the following documents:
 - *For female candidates enrolling in the first year of a bachelor's or single-cycle degree course:*
A copy of the latest available school report card from the fifth year of high school (with grades from the first term/trimester/pentamester and, if available, the entire school year).
 - *For female candidates already enrolled in University:*
A certificate of exams passed with the study plan; for bachelor's graduates, the corresponding degree certificate is also required (documentation issued by the university or via online certification from the university website).

Each female candidate will be contacted by phone or email and invited to an interview with the Residence staff, to be held preferably in person or alternatively online.

5. EVALUATION CRITERIA AND PLACE ASSIGNMENT

For the formulation of the ranking list, points are awarded based on qualifications and following an interview with the Residence Staff. Specifically, the following are considered for the ranking list:



Qualifications	Grade point average (based on the fifth-year high school report card for candidates enrolling in university for the first time) Academic average and credits (for candidates already enrolled in university)	Max. 10 points
Interview with the staff	Evaluation of motivation for study, social skills, and aptitude for group life	Max. 10 points
Duration of the requested accommodation period	Evaluation of the actual period of accommodation need	Academic year (11 months): 10 points From 5 to 10 months: 7 points From 2 to 4 months: 4 points Less than 2 months: 0 points

Eligibility for admission is conditional on reaching a minimum score of 22/30, obtained from the sum of the scores of the three evaluation elements.

The ranking list of admitted female students will be updated and available on the page <https://www.collegiomazza.it/residenza/marianum/> divided into **eligible winners** and **eligible candidates waiting for assignment**:

- **Eligible winners** include candidates requesting accommodation for the entire academic year (11 months).
- **Eligible candidates waiting for assignment** include all candidates applying for a shorter stay. They will be notified of any eventual place assignment and availability starting from September 20, 2026, until all available spots are filled. In the event of equal scores, priority will be given to the chronological order of application submission.

Each eligible candidate will receive an admission notice via email containing the accommodation contract proposal. The admission and place assignment are considered confirmed only after the Collegio receives the contract documentation signed by the candidate within five working days, along with the payment of the required security deposit.

6. FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTION

Upon admission, the candidate accesses all accommodation services at a cost proportionate to the chosen residential solution:

Single room: **500,00 €/month.**

Twin room (shared): **450,00 €/month.**

Twin room with a bathroom shared with another twin room: **400,00 €/month.**

Admission for the entire academic year is intended for 11 months from September 1, 2026, to July 31, 2027.

The monthly fee contribution to be paid by the student must be paid for 11 months even if they take possession of the accommodation place after September 1, 2026.

In the month of August, the Residence does not offer accommodation services, except in special cases to be agreed upon with the Collegio.

The monthly fee contribution paid to the Collegio by families can be deducted from tax returns. For detailed information, consult a Tax Assistance Center (CAF).

7. ANNUAL CONFIRMATION

Admission to the accommodation place is intended for one academic year. Confirmation for subsequent academic years will be subject to the Collegio's evaluation of the student's academic situation and the absence of disciplinary disputes relating to their presence at the Residence.

8. AN INCLUSIVE ENVIRONMENT

Collegio Mazza aims to be an inclusive environment and is therefore committed to breaking down cultural, relational, bureaucratic-administrative, physical, and architectural barriers to foster a sense of belonging, active participation, and responsible leadership for those undergoing the residential and educational experience in the various Residences. Inclusivity is based on the personalization of relationships during the reception, integration, and stay phases of the student, and on continuous listening fostered by frequent opportunities for meeting, exchange, and mutual acquaintance between the Management and the students. With this perspective in mind, candidates are invited to report any specific needs or special situations of hardship during the competition process.
